St. James United Church and Mary Street Centre take pride in being to partner with so many worthwhile organizations that provide services and support to our community. We hope to be able to continue to do so for many years to come and to be able to offer space at reasonable and affordable rates.

Every week from September to June, four or five community kitchen events are held at our premises. Local youth groups such as the Girl Guides, Brownies, and Boy Scouts meet here weekly. The Music Jam, held every second week, provides an inexpensive event where all members of our community can enjoy music, dance and perform. Many 12 Step programs meet here and we share our space with the Native Hand Drumming group, the Ba Hai Faith, and many others. We provide rental space to profit and non-profit groups for meetings and events at competitive rates. It would be our pleasure to give you a tour of our premises and provide you with a copy of our weekly calendar of events.

However, maintaining a building the size of St. James United Church is an expensive responsibility and balancing our budget is a priority. In order to help ensure this, we have embarked on a year long fundraising initiative. One of the largest of these fund raising events is the 'Spring in the Sound' event on Friday, April 26<sup>th</sup>. We begin the evening with a delicious roast beef dinner. Wine, beer, cider and a couple of signature cocktails will be available for purchase. After dinner, come and join us in the piano bar where vocalist, Sandra Kirby and pianist, Oleg Samokhin, will entertain us with 'The Possibilities of Love' - a great arrangement of songs from the 40s to songs of today. Dancing is encouraged. What a great way to spend a Friday evening and give back to your community at the same time. Tickets are \$50 per adult for dinner and the piano bar and \$20 per adult for the piano bar only. As well as individual tickets, tables of 4, 6 and 8 are available for purchase. 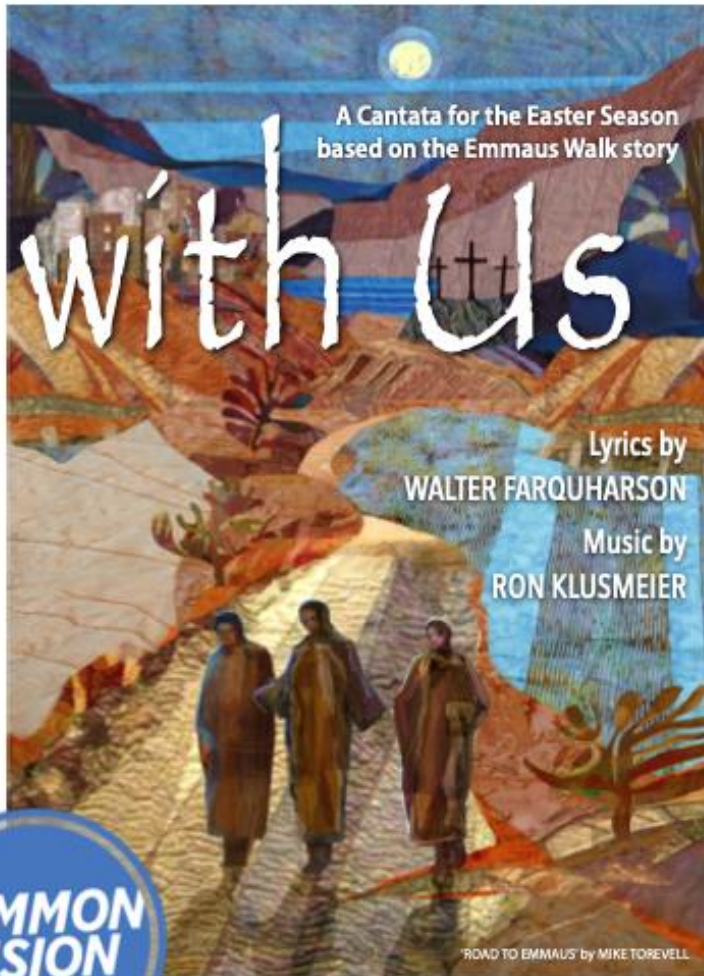
